OBJECTIVE: To encourage Eaglehawk youth to achieve their potential in their chosen field of arts which compliments the Festival program –

i.e. Literary, Visual or Performing Arts and Media Studies (film making).

- The scholarship is an effective way for the Eaglehawk Dahlia and Arts Festival Committee to recognise the art achievements and aspirations of an Eaglehawk Youth (residing in the 3556 postcode area). The scholarship is to encourage and assist young people to explore further study in his/her chosen field of the arts.
- Application for the scholarship must be completed on the Eaglehawk Dahlia and Arts Festival Inc. prepared application form.
- On receipt of the application forms the Assessing Panel will contact referees and research the applications.
- The Panel will then consider the applications and select a short list of applicants to be interviewed. The Panel will conduct interviews (usually in February), select the successful applicants and advise the Festival Committee President of their decision 10 days prior to the Official Opening of the 2020 Festival. The Panel Co-Ordinator will then advise the successful youth applicants.
- The Scholarship presentation, up to the value of \$1000 for Year 11 and 12 students and \$500 for Year 7 to 10 students, will be made to the successful applicants at the official Opening of the 2020 Eaglehawk Dahlia and Arts Festival.
- Both the Festival Committee President and the applicant will be required to sign a letter of accountability (attached).
- The successful applicant would be required to contribute to the Festival in their chosen Art field in an appropriate context.
- The Panel decision is final.

CRITERIA

The youth is to be a resident within the boundaries of the postcode district 3556.

To be in the age limit of 12 years to 18 years as at 1st January 2020.

To be studying an art with an aim of using same in a future career path. Arts designated to be Literary, Visual or Performing Arts.

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Information required complimenting your APPLICATION form.

1. Activities undertaken

Set out details of how you have made significant progress and contribution to the Arts forum including any positions held/activities undertaken, awards received together with date of such activities.
