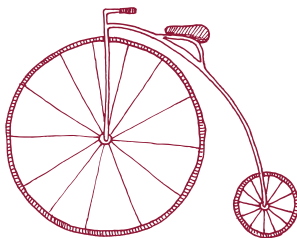

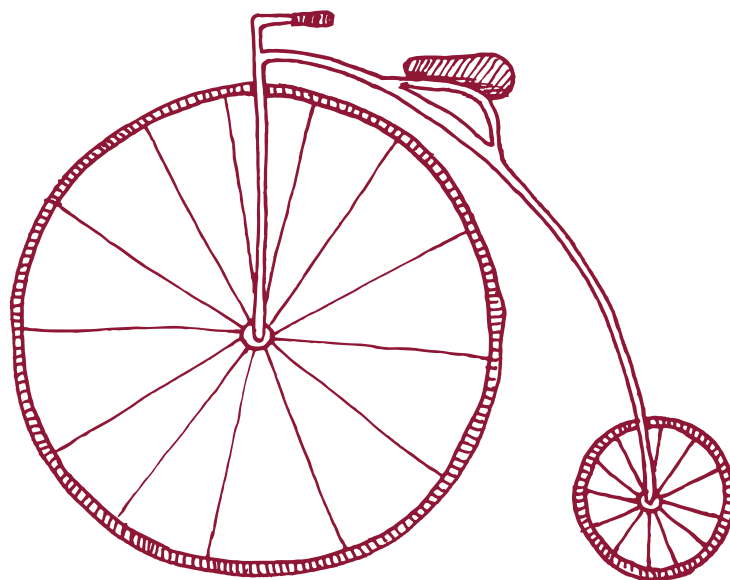

GUIDELINES

1. All entries must be original, unpublished and not have won any previous award
 2. Entries must be typed and double spaced using Times New Roman 12 pt, and if printed, on single sided A4 paper
 3. If posting, send only copies (all entries will be shredded after judging)
 4. Name to be on entry form only
 5. Copyright remains the property of the writer
 6. Entry fees or proof of EFT payment must be enclosed with entries
 7. No limit to the number of entries. \$5 entry fee to accompany each entry
 8. Extra entry forms may be downloaded from the festival website www.ncgrl.vic.gov.au/mulgabillwritingaward
 9. Winners will be notified by phone and announced at the festival opening in March 2021 (or online if the Festival does not go ahead)
